Please assist with managing this patient: medications on pages 8-9.

A 76-year-old female with CKD and heart failure was seen due to increased weight:

- 10 lbs in 3 months
- 6 lbs in 2 months
- 4 lbs in 1 month
- BLE edema

She denies SOB, CP, and no orthopnea; Torsemide increased to 40mg 5 days a week from 20mg 4 days a week. Her kidney function is Crt 2.73, BUn 64, and GFR 16. CL 113. No complaints. Continue to monitor. She remains DNR DNI DNH. The goal is comfort.

#### **DETAILS**

Thank you for the consultation. Please consider the following:

- 1. Cease amlodipine
- 2. Administer torsemide 40 mg daily, salt-poor albumin 12.5 grams 25% q12h for 3 days. Alter the diet to renal and 2 gm Na+ and restrict the volume to I.2 daily.
